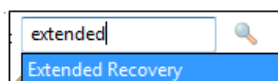

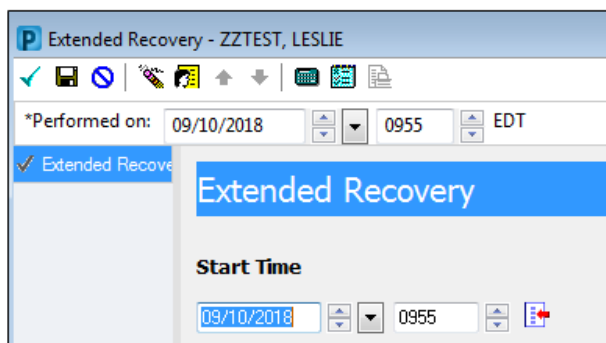
Extended Recovery

Extended Recovery is a status for outpatients who go to a nursing unit for recovery, beyond their recovery time in PACU. The patient PSO will be for an outpatient in a bed with an order for extended recovery.

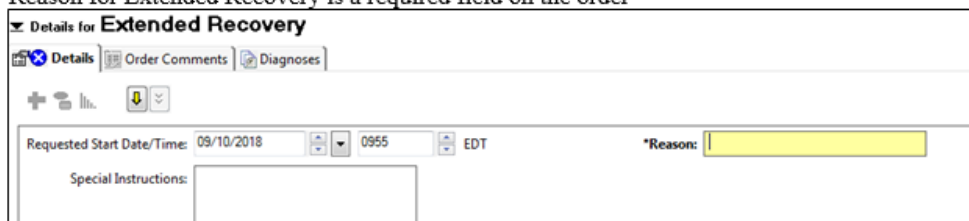
1. Provider enters order for Extended Recovery



2. Power Form appears as soon as order is selected; provider to complete start time; it automatically defaults to order entry time.



3. Reason for Extended Recovery is a required field on the order



4. Extended Recovery task appears for nursing

CERNER FLASH

- When nurse enters a stop time, minutes are auto-calculated.
Stop time Criteria – When the patient is discharged from the department OR when the PSO is changed from an “outpatient in a bed” to an “inpatient”.

Units to Charge

Charging units are equivalent to hours in extended recovery:

0 - 59 minutes = 0 units
60 - 119 minutes = 1 unit
120 - 179 minutes = 2 units
180 - 239 minutes = 3 units
240 - 299 minutes = 4 units
300 - 359 minutes = 5 units
360 - 419 minutes = 6 units
420 - 479 minutes = 7 units
480 - 539 minutes = 8 units
540 - 599 minutes = 9 units
600 - 659 minutes = 10 units

- The nurse then uses the units grid to determine how many units of extended recovery the patient received and enter that number into the required field.
