



Effective 5/6/24: A new **Yes** radio button for “**Patient Declined Depression Screening**” will be added to the bottom of the **PHQ2** and **PHQ9** sections of Intake Forms. When appropriate, users may select the Yes radio button next to this option if the patient declines to answer the depression screening questions.
