Have you heard? There is some EXCITING news regarding documentation of restraints in ONE McLaren Cerner! Starting November 21, 2023, you will notice that there is significant improvement in the documentation for restraints. You no longer need to remember which documentation elements are needed for each step in the monitoring process, nor start a Dynamic Group. Additionally, the Restraint Monitoring tasks are no longer set as scheduled; they are a Done/Not Done task. They will serve as a visual reminder to document in iView. Below are examples of the new tasks and documentation elements.

Task Examples:

There is one documentation field in the enhanced restraint documentation that will open up all of the required elements for the response:
