


Cerner Flash

As part of McLaren Health Care’s **“We Ask Because We Care”** initiative, there will be changes to the ONE McLaren Cerner Social History documentation. Effective Monday November 20, 2023, there will be a new option available for documentation within the Sexual section of Social History. The new option is **“Patient Under Age 18 (Not required to Ask)”**. Formal education regarding the initiative will be assigned via McLaren University beginning Friday December 1st (with completion due by March 31, 2024).

NOTE: On April 1, 2024, these questions will be required to be completed on all admissions.
