PSO Inpatient Certification Rule

- **Issue:** It was identified during testing that this rule is not firing in PRODUCTION. This rule will allow certification form to be signed when PSO order is written.
- **General Solution:** When placing order for PSO inpatient on Medicare patient's certification is required. Secondary rule is firing if/when admitting physician opens chart
