Ambulatory: New HPI and ROS Shared Components

HPI – Shared and ROS - Shared Components Overview

Enhancement: Effective **4/18/23**, new **HPI – Shared** and **ROS - Shared** multi-contributor components will be available for all Providers and Clinical Staff on their Outpatient Workflow Page in PowerChart. Clinical Staff may utilize these components to enter HPI or ROS documentation at the Provider’s discretion. Providers will be able to review this documentation and add/modify it as desired. All documentation entered in these components will pull into the Provider’s note.

Prior to this enhancement on the Outpatient Workflow Page (current state):

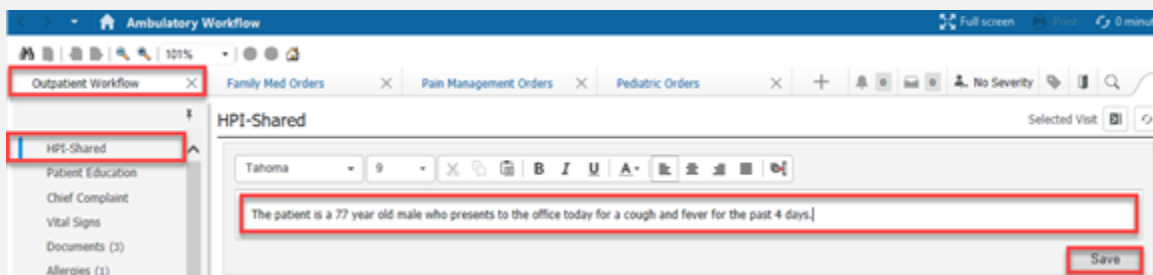
- **Clinical Staff:** did not have access to the HPI and ROS components.
- **Providers:** use the Subjective/History of Present Illness and Review of Systems components. Documentation entered here is only seen by the user who entered it. These two components will be removed and replaced with the Shared components as described above.

Ambulatory Positions Impacted: All Ambulatory Providers (including Behavioral and Women’s Health) and Clinical Staff.

- **Note:** This enhancement does not pertain to Oncology positions at this time.

HPI – Shared and ROS Shared Components

- 1) Open the patient’s chart in PowerChart. The **HPI – Shared** and **ROS - Shared** components will display on the **Outpatient Workflow** tab for users to document any desired information pertaining to the visit.
 - a. Select **the** appropriate shared component from the Navigation Pane.
 - b. **Single-click** within the component to add desired instructions.
 - c. Click **Save** when done.



- 2) Documentation entered here can be seen by multiple users and will pull into the Provider’s note once created. It is important for Providers to review the documentation to ensure its accuracy.
