Preventative Visits - Wrong Dx Charge Notification

Workflow Changes Overview

Update: Effective Wednesday, August 26th, if a Provider adds an incorrect diagnosis to a Preventative Visit charge order, a Discern Alert will prompt including appropriate order diagnoses for the Provider to review and replace on the Orders page.

Positions Impacted: All Ambulatory Provider Positions

Placing and Correcting Preventative Visit Diagnosis

In this scenario, the Provider places the incorrect Preventative Charge Order Visit Diagnosis. Below demonstrates what the Provider will see on their end, and how to correct the order diagnosis for both Pediatric and Adult Patients.

- 1) Provider adds an incorrect This Visit Diagnosis to a Preventative Charge Order.
- 2) After placing the Preventative Visit Charge Order, a Discern Alert prompts notifying the Provider of an incorrect Charge Order Diagnosis. This diagnosis trigger will be different for Pediatric (Ages 17 and under) vs. Adult (Ages 18 plus) Patients. Seen below are the Discern messages.

Pediatric Patients:

Discern: (1 of 1)

Order Diagnosis selected: Z00.00

Initial Comp Preventive Med less than 1 order is for pediatric preventative visit. Use the Order Diagnosis code appropriate for pediatric patients:

- Z00.110 Health examination for newborn under 8 days old
- Z00.111 Health examination for newborn 8 to 28 days old
- Z00.121 Encounter for routine child health examination with abnormal findings (29 days to 17 years old)
- Z00.129 Encounter for routine child health examination without abnormal findings (29 days to 17 years old)

Adult Patients:

Discern: (1 of 1)

STOP!!!

Order Diagnosis selected: Z00.110

Initial Comp Preventive Med 18 to 39 yea order is for adult preventative visit. Use the Order Diagnosis code appropriate for adult patients:

- Z00.00 Encounter for general adult medical examination without abnormal findings
- Z00.01 Encounter for general adult medical examination with abnormal findings

- 3) Based on the Discern Alert, the Provider will review the listed appropriate diagnosis codes and click OK to the message, which will bring the Provider back to the Diagnosis window on the Orders page. Then the Provider will add the correct diagnosis and sign the order.
