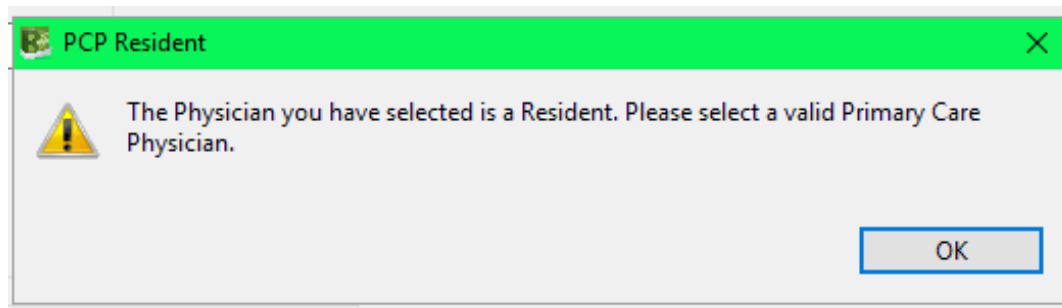
Resident Change in PCP Fields

Starting on 9/21/2022, Residents will no longer be able to be selected as the Primary Care Physician (PCP) in the corresponding registration fields in both Revenue Cycle / CPM and PMOffice / Schapptbooks / WIN32. A valid PCP should be documented in these fields instead. Both venues will receive a pop-up instructing the user to change the physician to a valid PCP.

This change is to help ensure that the correct PCP is documented at time of service to drive successful operational workflows.

Revenue Cycle / CPM

In Revenue Cycle, once the conversation is saved and a Resident PCP is listed the following message will appear. The conversation will not save successfully until a non-Resident PCP is documented.



PMOffice / Schapptbooks / WIN32

In PMOffice, as soon as a Resident PCP is selected, the following message will appear. The system will automatically clear out the PCP field after OK is selected.
