



Improvements to the Operative Report Surgical and Procedural Areas

Procedure – information will now populate from the **Additional Procedure Details** in the Intraoperative report completed by nursing. Previously the information populated with the scheduled case information. Verification of the procedure should be completed during the case debrief.

Assistant – Fellow and **First Assistant Relief** will automatically populate the report if documented as a case attendee in the Intraoperative report.
