Pain Documentation Overview


Enhancement: Effective today, all Pain documentation completed by Clinical Staff within the Ambulatory Comprehensive Intake form will now pull into the Provider's note.

Prior to this Enhancement: Only the Numeric Pain Score pulled into the Provider's note.

Positions Impacted: All Ambulatory Provider positions.

Pain Documentation in the Provider's Note

1) Clinical Staff will satisfy the **Pain** fields in the **Ambulatory Comprehensive Intake** form when appropriate during patient intake.


