



PathNet ICU Results

As we continue to navigate workflow changes with the PathNet Go Live an issue has been raised regarding laboratory turnaround time for ICU patients. Staff are advised to order any critical test as STAT when results are needed urgently. Providers should also review Power Plans to determine if appropriate test timing is ordered for labs in their Power Plans. A thorough review of all critical care power plans will commence immediately, but in the short term, we are also assessing as to whether a system setting change to default ALL labs from the ICU to STAT status can be activated in One McLaren Cerner and PathNet. While we work on this issue, please remain vigilant to the timing parameter of laboratory tests for ICU patients.

See below if results are needed rapidly, a STAT collection priority is chosen.
