Soon there will no longer be an ability to manually add or remove an isolation attribute in Capacity Management. Isolation attributes will display automatically based on active isolation orders in the medical record. When an isolation order is discontinued, the attribute will drop from Capacity Management

CareView Bed Boards:

Attributes for high-risk Braden, Morse, and bed alarm patients will be added to the CareView boards on the nursing units based on assessment documentation.

	Braden High Risk	(1)
	Bed Alarm	(1)
	Fall Risk	(1)

Documentation that triggers accompanying icons:

- Braden Score: ≤ 18 or Braden Q Score: ≤ 16
- Environmental Safety Implemented field: If response of Fall Precaution alarm on or Bed Alarm is documented in the last 36 hours the Bed Alarm icon will display
- Morse Fall Score: ≥ 45

When an improved score is documented outside of the trigger range; or if more than 36 hours passes since a bed alarm was documented, the icons will no longer display.
