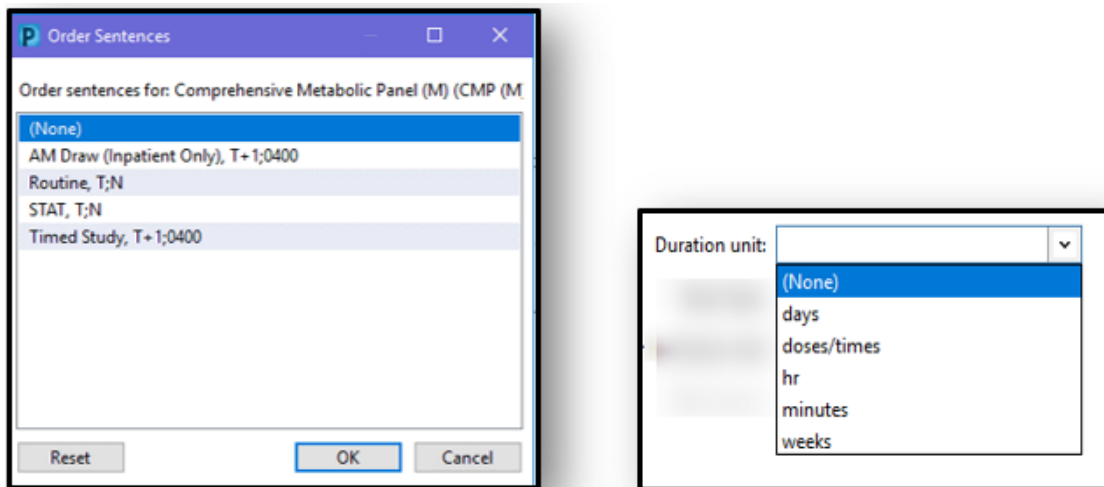

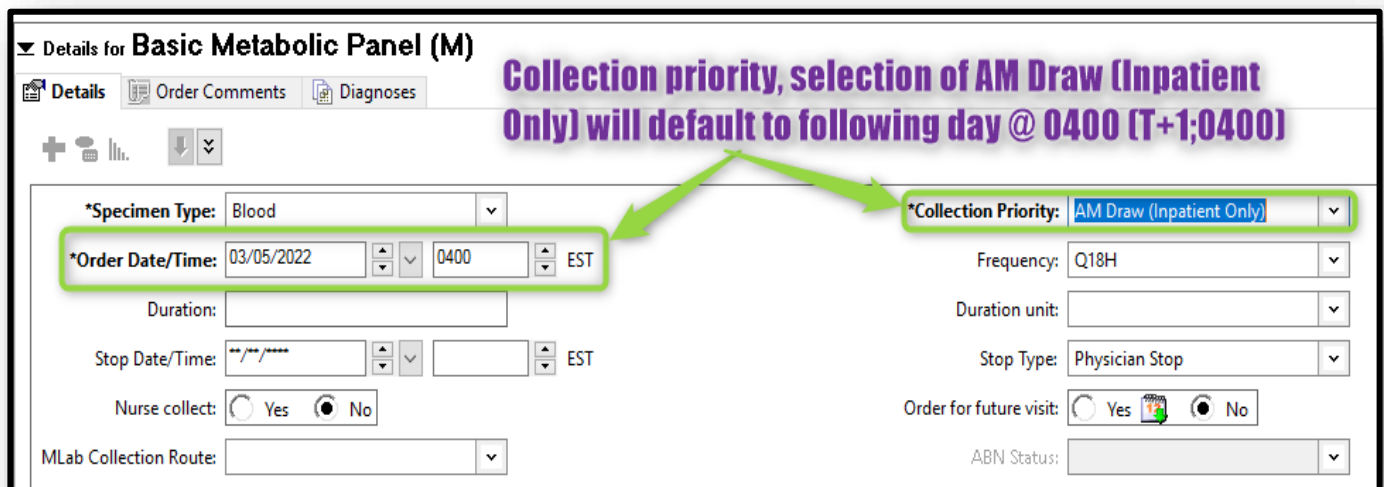
Lab Order Sentences

Lab sentences for common lab orders have been updated to the following:



With the update of the duration units to doses/times, if you need a serial lab like a high sensitivity troponin 2 times, you will no longer receive an error message.

Now when you choose AM lab, the order will automatically default to the following day

We hope that this makes the ordering process easier to get what you need without additional clicks for AM lab, routine, and stat labs.

If your morning lab is for a patient where an early AM result is critical to their care and you are at a site very remote from the main lab, you can choose the T+1 (today plus 1 = tomorrow morning if ordered before midnight) 0400 Timed order to get the lab earlier. Please only use that when the timing is key for care.
