## MODIFYING FINALIZED DYNAMIC DOCUMENTATION

### **Workflow Changes Overview**

Previous Steps: Previously when modifying a finalized document, providers could only add an addendum.

• Addend option is available for a 180-day timeframe.

**New Steps:** Providers can now **Revise** a finalized document, which allows for modifications within any section.

• **Revise** option is available for a 30-day timeframe.

#### **Revising Final Signed Documents** 1.) When choosing the option to Modify a document, a new dialog box will display. Acute Diabetes Educator Note This note has already been signed. Would you like to Addend or Revise it? Addend Note 2.) To revise the contents within your Revise Note document, select Revise Note, then click OK.
