## Ambulatory - Single-Patient & Multi-Patient Task List Enhancements **December 31, 2020**

### Task List Enhancements Overview

**Enhancement 1:** **Effective 12/31/20**, the tabs and columns located on the Single-Patient and Multi-Patient Task List will display in a more productive order and will default to the **Office/Clinic Task** tab when the task list is viewed.

**Enhancement 2:** Primary Care and Primary Care OB positions will now have access to the Multi-Patient Task List. Both task lists will display as described below.

**Positions Impacted:** Ambulatory Clinical Staff, Primary Care & Primary Care OB positions.

- **Important Note:** *Users will have to reset their Location and Timeframes on all task lists due to this enhancement.*
