Thank you for your interest in volunteering at McLaren Lapeer Region. The volunteers at McLaren Lapeer Region provide an important support system for hospital staff and patients donating as many as 20,000 hours each year! As a volunteer, you'll have an opportunity to learn new skills and expand your interest as you help people in need. Listed below you will find some helpful information regarding some of the volunteer requirements:

- After completing the volunteer application, you may be contacted for an interview. Once the interview process is complete you will be scheduled for Hospital Orientation and a TB (tuberculosis) Test. As a healthcare facility we take safety, patient confidentiality, dress code, and conduct seriously, all of which will be discussed and reviewed during orientation. Lunch will also be provided at orientation and we ask that you dress business casual (no jeans).
- Volunteers are required to work one-day per week for a four-hour shift. The shifts are normally 8am-noon, or noon - 4pm Monday - Friday. A minimal amount of weekend shifts are available.
- Please list two or more areas that you are interested in providing volunteer service.
- Female volunteers are required to wear a burgundy smock and male volunteers are required to wear a Blue Smock. We provide the smock and an Identification Badge. The ID badge does provide security access into and within the medical center.
